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Subject: Statement about the Veda Filter effects

We are a family farm with a long tradition of top quality natural vinegar production, as evidenced by numerous awards received at home and abroad.

In January 2015, Thomas called me and asked if I would like to test a new water filter for limescale, which he himself developed. Because I was convinced that this will take up a lot of time and demand an intensive intervention in the plumbing, I delayed my answer, as we were just in a very intense period in our production. After repeated contacting and talking about this filter I finally decided in March: "OK, let's do it, when?" - "Right now." - "Are you somewhere close?" - "No, we'll install it via phone, it will take a minute or two."

You can imagine my surprise? And indeed, in no more than 5 minutes he completed the installation with his protocol and the water was different in taste and purity.

We moved into our new apartment in 2012 and we have always had problems with limescale. Already the plumber told us we would, because we live in an area with very hard water. The difference after the installation is more than obvious, as there is literally no more limescale. We hardly use any cleaning products or shampoo, because it's not needed, yet our hair is not greasy.

But the biggest surprise was yet to follow. In September 2015, we talked after some time and discussed the effects of the filter, as they interested him very much. During our conversation he mentioned that his colleague Blanka from Murska Sobota had a plastic bottle for watering her plants. Prior to the installation of the filter that bottle was completely covered with limescale and algae, and that all of the covering disappeared in about a week after the installation.

That's when I exclaimed: "Oh that's it? I completely forgot to mention something!" - "What?"

In the production of vinegar, we use the so-called technical water to cool the fermentor, the temperature range of the cooling water varies from +4 to +20 degrees Celsius. The reservoir contains about 2,000 liters of water, and usually I had to change it once a month, because the water was full of algae and began to stink.

I even tried adding algicide to prevent algae growth, but I had to dose it every two weeks and beside that I wasn't very satisfied with the effect. And moreover I had a problem with this waste water.

But since we installed the Veda filter (March 2015), and until that September day we haven't changed the water, because it has been crystal clear and drinkable, no trace of algae and it isn't smelly. That has continued to this day. That is, for 20 months, we have not changed it, not even once and we haven't added any water either, as it simply doesn't evaporate. This way we saved on production stagnation time, problems with cleaning the system and believe it or not, 40.000 liters of water. I do not understand it a bit ... but the effect is obvious.

Thank you Thomas for this invention and we recommend it to everybody.

A supplement on 12th October 2016:

On Saturday, October 8th, 2016, I decided to finally change the technical water and would like to share my observations:

- I noticed a very thin, brownish film (in my opinion probably dust particles that settled down in these 20 months?) on the surface of the water;
- while pumping the 2,000 litres, I could not believe my eyes and called the whole family together, so that they could witness what I am going to say: the entire water was crystal clear, without any turbidity;
- there was absolutely no cleaning of the fermenters components necessary, which usually requires a considerable amount of time and effort;
- Evgen would not be Evgen if he did not dare an additional experiment:
I scooped 1 decilitre of the water and tasted it – it was of the same taste as freshly poured, really incredible!

Thomas was quite upset, as we forgot, in our excitement, to document everything by photo or video, or at least call him to do it. From now on, we will be more careful to look at the happenings around the newly filled water.
